Eligibility:

In order to qualify for CS Travel Grant funding, all of the following must apply. You must be:

- Registered as a full time UCI graduate PhD student at the time of conference paper submission.
- Attending a professional research conference.
- Presenting your own original work at the conference you are applying for funding to attend.

Important Award Information:

- Students can earn one travel award per academic year (Fall Quarter through and including the following Summer).
- Awards up to \$2,000 each student.
- Awards will be issued as a travel reimbursement for actual expenses only.
- Expenses are subject to UC Travel Policy.
